在我身上的恩典。大約在2020 年3月,我和媽媽到英國探望親 戚朋友,當時英國的疫情並沒 有香港那麼嚴重,所以很順利 便到達當地。誰不知,當我們 在英國逗留到第八天的時候, 航空公司發了一個電郵通知我 們後天回港的航班取消,需重 新訂購另一張機票。我和媽媽 頓時感到徬徨,因媽媽要趕返 香港工作,而我需回校補課。 而且當時購買機票是很不容易 的,因着回港航班很少,機票 售價炒至高幾倍甚至十倍價錢 發售,而且也未必購買得到。 於是我和媽媽便立刻回睡房懇 切禱告,求上帝憐憫,寬恕我 們的罪,讓上帝帶領我們前面 路向。過了半小時,奇妙的事 情發生了,我們聽到房外有人 敲門,原來是親戚通知我們找 到了機票回港,請我們立刻處 理。我當時感受到上帝的全知 全能,祂是無所不在、無微不 至的。感謝主!哈利路亞!

以上兩件事情都讓我深深 體會神對我無盡的愛,因此當 我踏入十四歲的時侯,便立心 申請接受洗禮加入教會,願意 往後一直跟隨主耶穌。

I am Chan Shun Yan, a Sunday school student of Kowloon Middle Class A. Since I was a child, I have followed my mother to Pentecostal Mission. When I was younger, I often heard preachers and Sunday school teachers share about the baptism of the Holy Spirit. In the five years from the age of two to seven, I was convinced that the Holy Spirit was what a Christian need. When I was a little more than 7 years old, a pure-hearted me knelt and prayed, earnestly confessing my sins to God. I told God that I knew I had not taken Him seriously in my daily life, such as sleeping or painting during prayer time when I was younger. Soon God gave me the precious Holy Spirit. At that time, I felt that I was uttering a sheeplike sound, and I was very close to God. That was followed by a feeling of peace and joy in my

heart. Praise the Lord!

I would also like to share here another incident of God's grace to me. Around March 2020, my mother and I went to visit relatives and friends in the UK. At that time, the epidemic in the UK was not as severe as that in Hong Kong, so we arrived there smoothly. Unbeknownst to us, on the eighth day of our stay in the UK, the airline company sent an email to inform us that the flight back to Hong Kong was cancelled and another ticket had to be re-booked. At that time, my mother and I felt anxious because she had to rush back to work in Hong Kong, and I had to go back to school for lessons. Moreover, it was not easy to buy air tickets at that time, as there were few flights back to Hong Kong. The airfare was several or even ten times the usual price, and there might not be any left for us to purchase. So my mother and I immediately went back to the bedroom to pray earnestly, asking God to have mercy and forgive our sins, and to lead us forward. After half an hour, something miraculous happened. Someone was knocking on the door of our room. It turned out that it was a relative who told us that they had found a return ticket to Hong Kong, and asked us to deal with it immediately. I felt God's omniscience and omnipotence. He is omnipresent and cares for us meticulously. Praise God! Hallelujah!

The above two incidents made me deeply appreciate God's endless love for me, so when I reached fourteen, I decided to apply for baptism to join the church, and I was willing to follow the Lord Jesus till the end.

我以前沒有和很多人分享 過這個經歷。直到教友鼓勵我 與他人分享,她幫助我明白到 這次經歷是一次非常特別的經 歷,能為上帝作見證。

I am Nigel Cheung. I recently got baptised on 21st November, 2021.

Having been brought up in a Christian family, my parents have been bringing me to church since I was a child. I was quite fascinated about the process of baptism at that time. Watching from the balcony, I found it quite amusing as a child. However, as I grew older, I began to understand the meaning of baptism.

Quite a few years ago, some of my friends at church chose to be baptised. At that time, I struggled with the idea of getting baptised. I wanted to get baptised, but I was reluctant to take the step to do so. I didn't get baptised that year. Last year, when the event was announced, I struggled with the idea, but still came to the conclusion that I would not be baptised. However, on that particular Sunday (please excuse my poor memory, I forgot the date), during Sunday school, my teachers encouraged us to think about getting baptised. They pointed out that we shouldn't hesitate and should take action immediately.

I still hesitated. In the praying time after Sunday school, I asked God to strengthen my faith and to take that step forward. All of a sudden, there was this urging feeling. I felt a very strong urge to go up to the preacher to apply for baptism. I couldn't pay attention for the whole morning sermon. Then in the afternoon, I asked

God again. I was still unsure. But then the feeling came back again, stronger than ever (It's quite hard to describe the feeling). So, right after the afternoon service, I immediately sought out the preacher. The rest is history.

I didn't share this experience with many others before. It was only until a member of the church encouraged me to share it with others. She helped me realise that the experience was a very special one.

"Be not afraid, only believe." Mark 5:36 (KJV) I hope my experience can help others strengthen their faith in God during these times of uncertainty.

回想2021年的一次颱風 中,因着烈風襲港,窗外大雨 滂沱,不能外出,我與家人多 了相聚的時間。母親當時鍥而 不捨地追問我什麼時候受浸, 提醒我接受洗禮是基督徒應盡 的責任。感謝神!我相信是神 的靈在我心中工作,使我不像 以往一般感到厭煩。在窗外風 雨交加、天色昏暗的環境下, 神藉着母親的提醒,讓我回顧 主在我生命中的看顧和帶領。 經歷了各種神的恩典和信實, 主的靈給了我受浸的勇氣。 記得彼得前書3章21節曾述: 「這水所表明的洗禮,現在藉 着耶穌基督復活也拯救你們; 這洗禮本不在乎除掉肉體的污 穢,只求在神面前有無虧的良 心。」感謝主!我那剛硬的心被神的愛融化了,有勇氣受浸歸主。藉洗禮表示我願意在神面前懺悔自己的罪,承認自己的虧欠。

"A time for everything" is not an excuse; The Lord saves me from sins.



It is written respectively in Acts 2:38 and 22:16 - "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." "And now what are you waiting for? Get up, be baptized and wash your sins away, calling on his name." Although I have always felt that the Lord is real, deep down I still had many excuses to avoid turning to Him. Looking back on my life, the Lord has cared for me with infinite tolerance and patience. This made me determined to no longer avoid Him, and to gather the courage to be baptized and join the church on November 21, 2021, confessing my faith in front of everyone.

When it comes to baptism, I had always felt that I would one day set my heart on getting baptized, but I was not sure when that would be, being at ease with everything that comes in my path. Having experienced God's grace and protection, I realized that I

grew up in the Lord's love. As such, despite my indecision and lack of courage, I finally gathered the courage to confess in front of everyone that Jesus Christ is my only Lord; He is the way, the truth, and the life. I rely on the Lord for His forgiveness and salvation by being baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Praise God!

During a typhoon in 2021, I could not leave home because of strong winds and heavy rains, and as a result I spent more time with my family. At that time, my mother kept asking me when I would be baptized, reminding me that being baptized is every Christian's responsibility. Thank God! I believe it was God's Spirit working in my heart that made me feel less tired of what my mother said than usual. Under the stormy weather outside, God reminded me through my mother of His care and guidance in my life. Having experienced all kinds of God's grace and faithfulness, the Lord's Spirit gave me the

courage to be baptized. As it is written in 1 Peter 3:21, "and this water symbolizes baptism that now saves you also—not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a clear conscience toward God. It saves you by the resurrection of Jesus Christ". Thank God! My hardened heart was melted by God's love and I had the courage to be baptized into the Lord. By baptism, I expressed my willingness to repent of my sins and confess my indebtedness before God.

"Produce fruit in keeping with repentance" (Matthew 3:8). I know my life would not be suddenly enriched by baptism. I believe however that it is a process by which a Christian learn to humbly follow the Lord's lead. I would adopt the attitude of being "in the world but not of the world", learn to love the Lord and others in different stages of life, and to work humbly and diligently for the Lord.



我是婁子謙,自幼在教 會長大,在2021 年受洗加入 教會。

在2020 年,我在大堂聽道時,聽到傳道人宣佈將舉行洗禮,當時心裡曾想及是否應該參與洗禮,但覺得自己未有資格及迫切性,所以在心裡跟神說自己會在下一年洗禮。

在2021 年,我再次在大 堂聽到有洗禮的機會,立即 回想我在去年曾跟上帝説會 在今年洗禮,但因為依然覺 得自己是罪人,未有資格, 所以再次跟神説不如再等一 年才再考慮。

及後幾星期內,母親不如以往數年,開始不停發訊息問我會否受洗加入教會,及後亦有直接跟我討論為何還未立志跟從耶穌,受洗加入教會。最後我經過多番思考,閱讀聖經及會規後,立志在2021年加入教會受洗。

回想一直以來,我一直 軟弱不肯接受洗禮的原因,是 因為以往曾聽宋監督説過:洗 

I am Arthur Lau. I was born and raised in the church. In 2021, I was baptized and joined the church.

Back in 2020, when I was listening to sermon, I heard the announcement that baptism would be held. At that time, I thought about whether I should apply for baptism, but I felt that I was not qualified and also there was no urgency, so I told God that I would consider the matter again next year.

In 2021, I heard again the announcement about another opportunity for baptism, and I immediately recalled that I had told God the year before that I would be baptized this year. But

because I still felt that I was a sinner and was not qualified, I told God again that it would be better to wait for yet another year and consider the matter then.

In the following few weeks, my mother, unlike in the past few years, began to send me messages asking me if I would be baptized and join the church, and also discussed with me why I still had not decided to follow Jesus and be baptized and join the church. Finally, after lots of thoughts, and reading the Bible as well as the rules of the church, I decided to join the church and be baptized in 2021.

In retrospect, the reason why I was weak and refused to be

baptized was because I had heard Superintendent Sung say: "you will not be saved by baptism, you are just a "wet sinner" if you continue to sin after baptism", and so I always planned that I would only apply for baptism after I received God's grace. But after lots of thoughts and reading the Scriptures, I understood that baptism is about accepting God and expressing my will before people. In the process of learning, God kept pushing me to think further about my relationship with God and the meaning of baptism. Therefore, I have the faith to decide to be baptized, and I hope to get closer to and know more about God.

I am Wong Ka Shun, and I just entered university this year. For the past two years, I have been through a period of low point in my spiritual life. Facing high school studies, the epidemic, and social events in Hong Kong, coupled with my lack of faith in the Lord, these worldly events lingered in my mind intermittently. But thanks to God, I had the opportunity to reconnect with Him through the HKDSE (Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education).

During the preparation for the HKDSE, many people sacrificed many things in order to get good grades. But I am grateful that I did not overly focus on my studies. As always, I entrusted my exams to God, and throughout this period I felt so at ease, as if God was with me.

In one of the HKDSE examinations, I was sent to a rather distant examination centre. During the intermission,

I found my wallet was missing! Losing my wallet not only cost me the fare to get home, but also prevented me from attending the second half of the exam and even the subsequent exams due to lack of supporting documents. Just when I started to panic, I suddenly remembered a saying that my parents always reminded me: "Trust in God in everything." I then found a quiet corner, sent a message to my parents, and immediately began to pray. During the prayer, I felt calm and stable, without the panic just now. Later, when my parents replied to my message, they also asked me to entrust the matter to God in prayer first. I knew at that time that God would help me. Praise God, I recovered my wallet in the exam hall and successfully completed the next exam.

After the HKDSE, I spent a lot of time at home because of the epidemic. I started thinking about my spiritual life. I recalled how God was always with me

and provided for me during the HKDSE so that I could go through this period with peace of mind. Whilst I was preparing for the exam, I still had the time to be close to the Lord. Thank God! No matter how busy I was or how bad my spiritual life was in the past, He did not mind my weaknesses. He helped me in every aspect and walked with me. I thought that I could not accept God's help unilaterally without reciprocating. So after realizing that being baptized into the Lord was something I should do, I applied for baptism.

Thankfully, although I had various thoughts and hesitations before applying for baptism, God gave me more faith through the encouragement of my brothers and sisters, affirming that this was the decision I should make. I am very thankful for God's amazing guidance in these few months, and I pray that the Father will continue to walk with me in the future.

我們生命中避不了遇上 壓力,這些情況可能讓我們擔 憂、感到焦慮或絕望。生活可 能充滿挑戰,但值得慶幸的 是,作為基督徒,我們有幸能 向上帝訴說我們所有的擔憂和 內衷的掙扎,相信祂會照顧我 們。

上帝一直在我的生命中, 而我亦已經準備好接受洗禮, 但祂不斷地告訴我要等待。上 帝明顯使我接受洗禮的事情受 阻,其一是我和家人因着與所 參加的教會在福音的教義和理解上有所不同,分別在我七歲和十五歲時離開了兩所我們長期參加的教會。因此,我未能在那兒接受洗禮,惟有繼續耐心等待。

我和家人目前在洛杉磯一 所教會聚集,上帝繼續阻延我 在那裏接受洗禮。事緣我最近 要到另一個城市去上大學,這 讓我難以參加教會洗禮前所需 的面授洗禮課程。疫情期間, 我們的教會開設了網上洗禮 班,我表示有興趣參加。但是 牧師叫我再等一會,因為有很 多年長的信徒也想受洗,要讓 他們優先。他的決定是可以完 全理解的,因為與長輩相比, 我因着新冠肺炎或其他疾病的 死亡機率相對較低。但當我告 訴朋友這個情況時,他們表示 難以置信!為什麼教會居然會 拒絕一個渴望接受洗禮的人 呢?但這確實發生了,正正是 我的經歷。

上帝一再關上我受洗的門 路,這讓我十分沮喪,不過, 祂仁慈地開啟了其他途徑。大 約在教會拒絕替我施洗的同 時,因着上帝的恩佑,我有機 會透過Zoom視像會議加入溫 哥華五旬節會的主日學。我最 初持懷疑及謹慎的態度,但最 終我給予自己一個月的「試用 期|嘗試其中。令我意想不到 的是,我真的很喜歡這個小 組,跟我以往參加的任何一個 小組相比,我和組員之間對福 音的理解是最相似和最有共識 的。上了主日學大約一年後, 父親問我是否希望在溫哥華教 會受洗。三年前他問過我同樣 的問題,當時我拒絕了。但這 一次,我認真去考慮了,並禱 告求神指引。

最終我知道上帝的旨意是 要我在這裏受洗,但我確實有 着一些保留。首先,由於疫情 仍然肆虐,我和家人擔心在旅 途中受感染或促進病毒傳播。 其次,我認為離開美國國境,

在這痛苦之中, 我於2016 年首次參加溫哥華夏令營,當 中得着鼓勵要多禱告,多讀聖 經。在一次我和媽媽參與的午 間祈禱會中,我感受到與上帝 同在, 這是我很久以來沒有感 受到的。夏令營過後, 聖靈繼 續在我心內工作。同年聖誕 節,上帝突然催促我禱告 — 這是自從我經歷抑鬱後很少做 的事。忽然,我感受到神的爱 澆灌我, 立時驅散了心中的黑 暗沉鬱,治癒了之前教會和會 友帶給我的傷痛。神同時讓我 經歷了罪赦, 這也是我沒想過 的。從那天晚上開始,我與上 帝的關係有着顯著的改善。如 果上帝沒有藉夏令營讓我與祂 重新連繫,我現在可能已經背 離了信仰。上帝以種種的方法 拯救了我。

The Power of God's Love

In life, it is inevitable that we will encounter stressful situations that may cause us to feel worried, anxious, or hopeless. Life can be challenging, but thankfully, as Christians, we are blessed with the ability to communicate all our concerns and struggles with God, trusting that He will take care of us.

For as long as I could remember, I have always believed that God was real, including the Bible stories where Jesus fed thousands of people with merely a few loaves of bread and several fish. There was never any reason for me to doubt His existence or my faith in Him. Hence, when I witnessed my first baptism service as a child, I felt a longing in my heart to get baptized as well. On that day, I remember a fellow congregant approached me after service and told me. "One day, it will be your turn," and I've waited since then.

God has always been in my life, and I have felt ready to receive baptism, but He continually told me to wait. One clear way God hindered me from being baptized was by compelling my family and me to leave two different

churches we attended long-term due to differing doctrines and understandings of the Gospel. This occurred twice, once when I was seven and another when I was fifteen years old. Under these circumstances, it was hard for me to pursue baptism, and I continued to patiently wait my turn.

God continued to delay me from pursuing baptism at the church my family and I currently attend in Los Angeles. Until recently, I was in university and lived in a different city, which made it difficult for me to attend the in-person baptism classes required for baptism. During the pandemic, our church opened the opportunity for online baptism classes, which I was interested in. However, the pastor asked me to wait because there were many elderly believers who also wanted to get baptized. This was completely understandable since I had a lower chance of dving from COVID-19 or another illness compared to my elders. When I shared this story with a friend, they were in disbelief! After all, why would a church reject a person for wanting to receive baptism? As I have experienced, it does happen.

God continued to close my doors, which was frustrating to face, but He mercifully opened others. Around the same time I was rejected from baptism. God blessed me with the opportunity to join Pentecostal Tabernacle Vancouver's Sunday School through Zoom, Initially, I was skeptical and cautious, but I gave myself a one-month trial period. Surprisingly, I really liked this group because our understanding of the Gospel was the most similar and compatible compared to any other groups I've joined. After attending Sunday School for about a year, my dad asked me if I wanted to get baptized in Vancouver. Three years ago, he asked me the same question, and I rejected the idea. This time around, I seriously considered it and asked God for guidance.

Ultimately, it was God's will for me to get baptized here, but I did have a few reservations. Firstly, it was during the pandemic, and my family and I were concerned about contracting or spreading the virus during our travels. Secondly, I thought it was superfluous to travel out of the

country, from the U.S. to Canada, to get baptized in a church that I didn't particularly have a strong affinity to. Lastly, a part of me wanted to avoid this church because it has been the culprit of other people's pain and grief, including those close to me. In my prayers, I still ask God, "Of all the churches in the world, why did you choose this one?" Admittedly, getting baptized here in Vancouver is not that farfetched because it's not the first time God used this church in my life.

A story I seldom have the chance to share is the time when God healed me and restored my relationship with Him. When I was fifteen years old, my family and I made the difficult decision to leave church a second time. which I briefly mentioned earlier. Due to church politics fueled by leaders and administration, we were implicated by their cruel actions and the false rumors they spread. As a result, I became extremely unhappy, anxious, and stressed to the point where I was consumed by darkness and disturbing thoughts. I felt like God had abandoned me because there was no light in my world.

Although I seemed fine on the outside, I suffered from turmoil internally. In essence, I had forgotten what it felt like to be loved by God.

Amid my suffering, I attended Vancouver Summer Retreat in 2016 for the first time, which encouraged me to pray and read the Bible. During an afternoon prayer session with my mom, I felt God's presence, which I hadn't felt in a long time. The Holy Spirit continued to work within me well after retreat. On Christmas of the same year, God suddenly urged me to pray-something I rarely did privately since experiencing depression. Without prompting, I felt a rush of God's love, which immediately drove out the darkness and healed me from the pain the church and its members caused me. Simultaneously, God allowed me to experience the Remissions of Sins, which I also did not expect. Since that night, my relationship with God has significantly improved. If God hadn't used the retreat as a way to reconnect me to Him, I probably would have denounced my faith by now. God saved my life, in more ways than one.

With my recent baptism, I think God wants me to be here, even if I don't completely understand why. My journey to baptism has been unexpectedly long and full of detours, but it has taught me to be obedient, faithful, and content. While my experiences and feelings may not be especially unique or special, I know God cares for me, and His timing is right.

In sharing my thoughts and feelings, I hope you may also feel encouraged to continue trusting in Him. Don't lose hope, even when in despair; God is faithful, and He loves each and every single one of us very much!

As Sunday school teachers we have the duties and responsibilities to pass on Biblical teaching and encourage students to establish a direct connection with God. Sister Elizabeth and I have this same goal - to give fellow students an enjoyable and lively learning experience.

By adopting different teaching resources, we can promote students' learning by drawing more relevancy to the Bible messages. The outcomes have been encouraging as we heard students would look forward to attending Sunday school and would share with us how they have experienced God in

their daily lives. Being able to witness their growth in faith and dependence on God in the past two years is the greatest reward as a teacher.

Teachers and students are like in a family. Regardless of how trivial or important the prayer request, we, including the teachers, would openly share our prayer needs and pray for each other aloud during class. We often praised God for answering our prayers. Over time, the class has established a trusting relationship; it is most invaluable to experience God's provision, teaching, comfort, and care, together as a class.

A personal appreciation goes to Sister Elizabeth for holding the fort when I had to travel frequently for business and family needs, she has provided a sense of stability for the students.

Besides working closely in Sunday school ministry, Elizabeth and I also share our burdens and pray for each other often. During the Christmas seasons, we would meet up to sort out the gifts for our students and spend time for deeper sharing. Over the years, this has become a little precious tradition.



Praise God since childhood, a loving Sunday school teacher brought me to attend Sunday School every week. Even though I am from an unbelieving family, I grew up in the Lord's teaching at an early age. How blessed it is to be nurtured and accompanied by the Truth as I went through every milestone in my life.

I do not feel worthy to take part in the Sunday School Ministry, but God accepts my limitations and has given me this opportunity to go deeper in knowing Him. Praise the Lord, through the interactions with the students and their thought-provoking questions, I was able to reflect deeper on the Truth myself.

When I first became a Sunday school teacher, my former coteacher shared that the goal of Sunday school is to create a happy and enjoyable experience for students so that they would be motivated to continue learning about the Biblical Truth and come to Sunday school. With that in mind, we used mini activities and games to aid with Bible storytelling and scripture memorization, all with the hope to deliver the Bible messages more

effectively so that students could apply the learning in their daily lives.

In the past two years, in addition to the regular sessions on prayer. scripture memorization, Bible storytelling, and singspiration, our class has added a component on personal Bible sharing. To build up a discipline on daily Bible reading, each week in class, each student and teacher would take turn to share the greatest learning from the past week's Bible reading. Guiding questions were provided on what to share - what happened, who were the key characters, why it happened, what are the Truths, and how to apply them in our lives.

When Sister Judy first proposed adding the Bible sharing component, I was weak in faith thinking that this would be too challenging for our students (aged 7-8), and that they would be reluctant to try. Praise God! At first, students had difficulties in articulating about what Truths they found and how they could apply them. But gradually, the students began to share how they have applied the Truths in their lives, even to the point

of sparking further discussions among classmates. These exchanges and interactions were far beyond my expectation of what could have happened.

Furthermore, together we practiced how to show care and concern to others around us. One time, students made some handicrafts with scriptures inscripted and gifted them to some elders at church. This helped bond the students and the elderly in the family of God, creating some sweet memories for each other. It is hoped that this could stay in their Journey of Faith and they will be willing to support each other along the way heavenward.

Sister Judy and I are still relatively green in the Sunday School ministry, but we are grateful to be able to learn from more mature teachers' experiences in dealing with issues from class, and are often encouraged by their sharing. Finally, I hope that all Sunday school students are able to grow in the love and the truth of God, and one day they may be the next Sunday school teachers to pass on the Lord's teachings to other young students.

新冠肺炎第五波疫情十 分嚴重,工作的地方開始有同 事確診。我和這位同事曾一起 緊密工作,當知道這位同事確 診後,自己也要做核酸測試, 七日後的報告是陰性的。之後 陸續有其他同事確診,至3月 3日晚我做快速測試時,今次 結果卻是陽性。我自知要為此 事檢討查察,但起初兩天仍感 到與主有阻隔,不明白為何主 准許此疾病臨到,我的信心明 明已放在主處呢!感恩長者在 電話中與我祈禱,神藉他勉勵 我,也道出我心中的懼怕。正 如詩篇77篇10節所言,自己有 思念及信心上的毛病,心想是 否主不喜悦自己,或者要懲罰

自己,才要我經歷這次感染。 再者,或許我內心懼怕的不是 這個疾病本身,而是它所帶來 的標籤和別人的看法。長者勉 勵我要更加安靜在主前,從靜 中得力。當我願意安靜、降服 在主前,主即時有很多提醒臨 到。其實在確診前的安息日, 我們的主日學班正學習啟示錄 七個教會其中的士每拿教會, 當中啟示錄2章10節上的一句 很入我心:「你將要受的苦你 不用怕。」學習這教訓的時候 自己還未確診,主提醒我: 「我豈不是在幾天前已經教導 你嗎?你不要怕將要遇到的苦 難!」感謝上帝,其實祂早已 為我注射了一劑信心的疫苗。

於是我又問主:「是否應該與主日學同工和同學分享自己確診的經歷?」因我很害怕會動搖他們的信心!我又記起長者的勉勵,有說話的時候,也有安靜的時候,只要多安靜祈禱,讓聖靈引領我在適當的時候講應講的話。

後來在主日學分享的時候,第一位同學正正分享他家中有家人染疫,他很坦誠告訴大家他在這段期間的感受,故在這段期間的感受,或是進出他的房間的時候,原來他也會感到很驚惶,他的信心在試煉來到時就顯出軟弱。聽着他的分享,我被他的坦誠所感動,

於是我也向同學們分享自己染 疫一事,以及主怎樣用祂的話 語來保護我和承托着我。確診 前大約一兩個星期,我在靈修 中曾讀到約伯記2章10節下: 「上帝賜福給我們的時候,我 們就高興, 祂降禍, 我們就埋 怨嗎?|於是我又想:「第一 次上帝保守我結果是陰性,我 就感恩讚美,今次結果是陽 性,難道我就埋怨嗎?|確診 後的第二天早上,我又讀到羅 馬書5章3至5節所述:「即使 在患難中,我們仍然歡喜,因 為我們知道患難培養忍耐,忍 耐產生毅力,毅力帶來盼望。 盼望不會使我們失望,因為上 帝诱過祂賜給我們的聖靈,將 祂的愛澆灌在我們心裏。|我 讀到主的話語時深受感動,祂 的話語滿有能力,能洗淨我的 內東、糾正自己思想上的錯 誤。有主的話語承托着我,我 還用擔心嗎?在安靜檢討查察 中,主讓我知道自己要改進的 地方, 這就如傳道人所教導, 我們要好像到曠野靜中禱告一

般。

家庭群組對話中都有叫我們多 祈禱。上帝將咒詛變為祝福, 是我想也沒有想過的!從我信 心軟弱,有思想上的毛病,到 主彰顯祂的愛,將愛澆灌在我 心裏,甚至在我未信主的家人 心中工作,我贵能不分享我的 見證呢?在我確診的第一晚, 四歲的兒子很不明白我為何要 「躲在房中」,大喊要我出 來。之後我們只可以透過視像 對話、遊戲和祈禱。後來,原 來兒子也有在網上主日學時告 訴老師和同學,媽媽染病要 「躲在房中」。感謝他的主日 學老師和其他兄弟姊妹都有慰 問我和為我代禱。在隔離期間 的每一個晚上,我透過視像和 兒子祈禱,平日都是我講一句 他跟着我講一句的,但突然有 一晚兒子説:「媽媽,今晚是 我講一句,然後你講一句!感 謝天父, 求天父醫治媽媽, 讓 媽媽快些出來!」天父又藉着 兒子鼓勵我,祂真是多麼的慈 愛!身為母親,在隔離期間, 心中很記掛兒子和女兒,最想 做的一件事就是可以無阻隔地 擁抱孩子。 同樣地,如果天父 和我們之間有阻隔,天父的心 的懷抱嗎?所以我們必須除去 一切思想上的謬誤和一切罪的 阻隔,讓主的靈和主的愛充滿 我們,填補信心上的凹洞,與 主重建無阻隔的關係。



感恩!讓我代表詩班分享主奇妙的帶領。在新冠疫情下,這兩年來,詩班經歷了不同的嘗試和安排,讓會眾在沒有實體聚集時,仍可聽到詩班的歌聲。這些一切,先要多謝兄弟姊妹新穎靈活建議,及錄音組的協助及技術支援。

有人問網上崇拜的詩歌錄音是從何而來呢?起初是我們由詩班以前灌錄的兩輯CD和錄音帶選出,及後時間久了,以前的錄音不夠使用了,我們便從平時安息日聚集的錄音中把獻詩部份剪輯出來。我們所選的詩歌有遠至2014年的錄音。因技術上有快慢速度需要調節,選好後還要加工,才可以播出。

在2021年雖然疫情仍然持續,但很感恩的是我爸爸因病信了主。

回想幾年前,我在暑假回 老家時找了一間教會,同時很 開心地帶了媽媽一起去 。當 時爸爸不但沒有跟我們去,還 很反對,但我對他說:「我已 長大,你阻止不了我信主。天 父是真神,我信了主這幾年, 心裏充滿平安喜樂。」事實上 信主之後,媽媽、我和女兒的 生命都有很大改變,我相信這 無形中也影響着爸爸。在老家 時,我一有機會就和爸爸讀見 證和聖經,後來爸爸還對我哥 哥說:「聖經可以看看,可吸 收內裏的精華 。」爸爸由最初 反對媽媽去教會,到後來每星 期日都駕駛摩托車送媽媽去教 會,也曾將錢給媽媽,吩咐她 到教會奉獻。

直至去年五、六月,卷 爸因腦梗塞導致非常嚴重的頭 暈,在醫院住了半個月也未見 好轉,後來還發展到嚴重失眠 和焦盧症,即使食安眠藥也不 能入睡,又不能進食,非常痛 苦。我提醒媽媽要向爸爸傳福 音,但因我不在爸爸身邊,唯 有每晚懇切地為爸爸禱告,痛 哭流淚求神軟化他的心,因為 爸爸未信主,而爸爸年紀又 大,我怕他有天離開塵世而不 能得救。在一個星期五晚聚集 時,我請傳道人在台上發出代 禱激請,請教會兄弟姊妹為我 爸爸禱告:聚會後我也有告訴 爸爸,勸勉他不要怕只要信。 當時爸爸是有平安的,我相信 天父愛爸爸多於我愛他。後來 我開始在電話和他分享一些聖 經,也鼓勵媽媽跟他一起禱 告。我對爸爸說:「爸爸,我 愛你,但是主耶穌才可以給你 生命,祂才可以擔當你的痛 苦……」我以前從來不會向爸 爸說我愛他,如果不是信了 主,我是不會這樣說的!感謝 神,痛苦的經歷會改變人心; 天父很奇妙,藉着爸爸肉身的 痛苦讓他謙卑,他在電話透過 視像對我說:「阿霞,我信 了,我甚麼都願意。」於是我 和爸爸一齊祈禱認罪,我說一句,他就跟我說一句。禱告後,我很開心地告訴爸爸他已得救,之後,爸爸每晚都向天父禱告,甚至向媽媽道歉,說以前對她不好,感謝神!爸爸現在睡眠好了,也能進食。

由於掛念爸媽心切,故我 在去年暑假決定和女兒一起回 老家。因疫情關係,我和女兒 要先在深圳的酒店隔離14日。 我知道將會面臨很多未知的困 難,所以走前請了很多人為我 們祈禱。過關的事情都是在網 上辦理,我全不懂,感恩全靠 女兒如小天使般幫我處理; 我 們又要適應隔離期間的膳食和 不斷地做檢測,而做檢測的過 程是最難受的。我和女兒無論 遇到大小事情,都會先祈禱交 託主,每過一關後,我們又感 謝天父; 雖然肉身受了一些 苦,但因我們很想念家人,又 記得在出發前聽道教導我們要 做守望者,知道這是一種責 任。後來我發現原來隔離的時 間比想像中長,而女兒回港後

但神的安排好特別,在 我很灰心難捱的時候,病房經 理加大力度要我去監察病房工 作,即是要去篩查入院病人有 沒有新冠病毒。那時我很想 拒絕,既擔心自己已經不夠 病房經驗在身,又不知會面對 什麼風險,不知道會不會影響 到同住的家人。那時神就讓我 回想2003年祂如何保守我經 歷沙士, 查察到自己更應該由 信進信。期間有同事提議我 申請到其他醫院工作,心裏 十五十六,聖靈就讓我想起以 賽亞書30章21節的經文:「假 如你哋徬徨路上,偏左或偏 右, 佢必對你哋說: 『路喺呢 處,照行啦。』」得到由主而 來的指引,以及主內護士組姊 妹每天金句分享及代禱,就完 成了超級精彩、有汗有淚但收 穫豐富的病房特訓。

感恩,主的憐憫與恩慈常 常在我左右,只是人在事忙中 常常看不到主的恩手。

去年聖誕前兩天,我約了一位姓蕭的牙醫補牙,(那家診所是一位梁醫生的診所,但內有三位不同的牙醫診症。)由於第一次在那家診所看病,所以要重新登記我的個人資料,如:姓名、住址、電話、職業、工作地址、病歷等等。

當蕭醫生替我檢查後, 她發現我有兩隻蛀牙需要補, 而我聽後即時有點憂慮,因我 當初只預算補一隻牙,所以沒 帶太多現金,而診所又只收現 金和支票,我擔心不夠支付費 用。當進行補牙前,蕭醫生看 我的個人資料後問我:「你的 職業『堂役』是甚麼工作?」 我答道是在教會做清潔工作。 完成補牙後,她叫我到接待處 等候, 常護士叫我的名字時, 他對我說:「你不用付款,可 以走了。」我當時以為人聲嘈 雜聽錯了,再追問清楚需付多 少?她重複説:「不需付款, 你可以走了」,我提高聲音對 她説:「吓!一元都不用付 嗎?|她再回答說:「是,可 以離開了。」

於是我疑惑地推開門走出 診所,但當時心想:「我在短 我感動的原因是:別人因 我是在教會工作,因着主基督 的緣故而優待我,他們就像馬 太福音10章42節:「因基督的 緣故給一杯涼水給小子喝」, 他們固然得到他的賞賜,而我 這接受涼水的小子又怎樣呢? 我自己又曾否因着自己是基督 徒的緣故而尊重過這名份呢? 我慚愧不已。

主啊,真是對不起,我是 不配得的,你為何還這樣恩待 我呢?我常常輕視你而跟隨舊 我做事,常常故意犯罪,藐視 主,而別人卻反而因我是屬基 督的緣故而厚待我,我真是愧 疚。

我在歸家途中致電 太太,把事件經過告知 她,她還問我說:「你

做了些其麼好事是我不知道的 呢?上帝竟然這樣恩待你?| 我回答説:「不是我做了些甚 麼好事,而我所認識的主基督 耶穌, 祂在我心中從來都不是 一個警察,只監察人的善惡而 施行刑罰;我所認識的主基督 是一個富有憐憫和慈愛的主, 祂不斷用慈繩愛索來牽引我 們,在我們犯罪時袖無聲地等 待,以慈愛來呼喚我們回轉, 使我們能心悅誠服地追隨祂, 領受祂的恩慈和引導,祂所給 的全是恩典和憐憫,並不帶責 罰,就像主對那行淫時被捉的 婦人説:『我也不定你罪,從 此不要再犯罪了。』(約翰福音 8章11節) 使我們這些徒受主 恩,但常常虧欠主的人心悦誠 服地尊敬主、愛主、跟隨主、 效法主。一哈利路亞!讚美 主,阿門。
